Educational Programs for Gifted & Talented Students

*K-12 grades students are eligible for nomination, and once nominated, an overview of the assessment process is offered to the parents.

*Program options enable gifted/talented students to work together as a group, and work independently during the school day as well as the entire school year.

*Students at all grade levels are involved in experiences that result in the development of sophisticated products and/or performances.

*Teachers who provide instruction and services that are a part of the program for gifted students have a minimum of thirty (30) hours of GT training and receive a minimum of six (6) hours annually of professional development in gifted education.

*Parents are informed of all gifted/talented services and opportunities. The campus provides orientation and updates for parents of students identified and served in gifted programs through parent meetings.



Digital Learning Environment

*Classrooms are student-centered learning environments where technology is seamlessly used to solve real-world problems, to bring critical thinking & questioning, student engagement and allow for daily informative assessments using technology tools.

*Campus has access to digital resources that allow application of technology across all subject areas as evidenced through interactive learning and application of technology.

*Teachers participate in multiple technology professional development opportunities to support student-centered learning and Future Ready skills by attaining 12 or more hours of professional development on an annual basis.

*All teachers show evidence of planning, organizing, delivering and evaluating instruction for all students that incorporates the effective use of technology integration into the curriculum.

*Campus Leadership promotes a shared vision that encourages innovation with technology evidenced in a Technology Implementation Plan that is aligned to the District's Technology Plan.
